










Maths

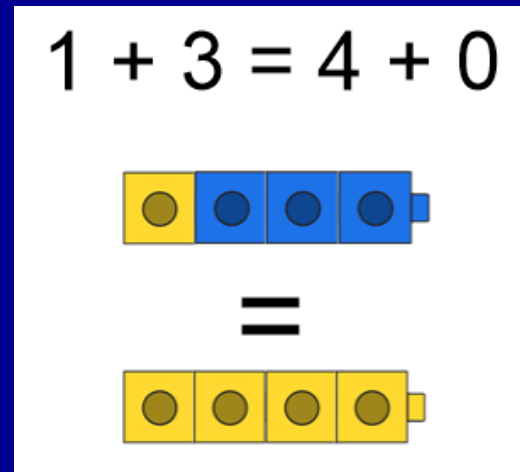
Our unit is exploring calculation strategies
