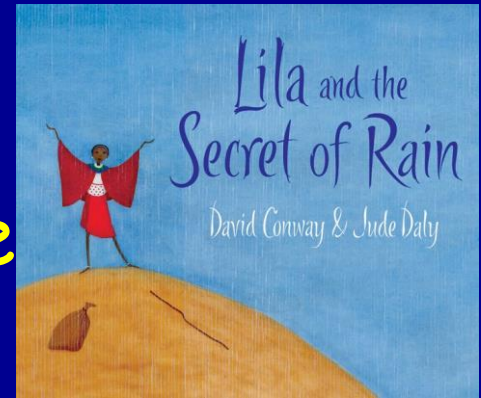
Sounds we have learnt this week.

English

Our new class text is *Lila and the Secret of Rain*!



We listened to some weather sound clips and used adjectives to describe the different types of weather.

We also described the different settings in the story.

Maths

Our unit is numbers to 50!

This week we have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

We have been counting objects in 2s and 5s.

We have also been finding missing numbers in number patterns. For example...

8, 10, 12, ____, ____, 18, 20, 22

First we looked if the pattern was increasing or decreasing (numbers becoming greater or smaller in value). Then we represented the pattern on a bead string or numberline to find out how many we were adding or subtracting each time.

Topic

Science - We have been learning about our new topic 'It's raining, it's pouring.' The children looked at different types of weather and thought about how it makes them feel and how we might dress for it. We then had a go at giving a weather forecast using a map and weather symbols.

RE - We have been learning about Palm Sunday and what happened to Jesus when he visited Jerusalem.

Geography - We have been observing the weather and recording this.

DT - We have been making our modified and improved teddy bears.
